Maui October 2012 Sales Statistics

Brief Maui Statistics Overview:

Page 4 - October's Sales Volume – October's Residential rose to a 5-year-high of 98 homes sold, while Condo Sales rose to 94 units sold. Land sales came in at 8 lots sold.

Page 5 - October's Median SALES prices – The Residential home median price rose to \$487,000, while the Condo median price increased to \$351,495. Land median price rose to \$297,500.

Page 6 - Days on Market for Residential homes = 139, Condos = 162 DOM, Land = 593 DOM.

(General DOM Note: this is the average DOM for the properties that SOLD. If predominantly OLD inventory sells, it will move this indicator upward, and vice versa. RAM's Days on Market are calculated from List Date to Closing Date [not contract date]. As such, it includes approximately 60 days of escrow time.)

Pages 10 - 14 – "Year to Date Sales" numbers compare January – October 2012 to January – October 2011. Short timeframe (monthly) views do not necessarily reflect the longer timeframe trends. Year to Date:

Residential unit sales decreased (765 homes sold/ +19 units YTD/ +3%), average sold price = \$689,249 (-14%YTD), median price = \$465,000 (+7%YTD) and total dollar volume sold = \$527,275,790 (-11%YTD).

Condo unit sales decreased slightly (1,009 units / +18 units YTD / +2%YTD), average sold price = \$453,209 (-10%YTD), median price = \$350,000 (+9%YTD). Total Condo dollar volume sold = \$457,287,814 (-8% YTD).

Land – NOTE: Land Lot sales are such a small sampling that statistics in this property class are not necessarily reliable indicators. Land lot sales increased (124 lots / +8 units YTD / +7%), average sold price = \$614,440 (+1%), median price = \$350,000 (+16%), Total dollar volume = \$76,190,567 (+8%).

Total sales for immediate past 12 months: Residential = 919 (with 36.9% being REO or Short Sale), Condo = 1,175 (26% REO or SS), Land = 142 (14.8% REO or SS).

IN A NUT SHELL..... the good, the bad..... AND THE ROAD AHEAD

Increased showings and sales, multiple offers on new "good" listings, hesitant buyers become onlookers...... Window of opportunity may be closing for first-time homebuyers (see below).

Well priced properties are attracting multiple offers making for a quick sale. Inventories have declined 17-20% over the past 12 months in Residential and Condo classes. Many short sales and REO (bank owned) properties are being absorbed as sales as we begin to move ahead to a more normal marketplace. Mortgage Interest Rates are still near historic record lows which may help motivate would-be Buyers to go ahead and buy IF they can qualify. While general U.S. economic news looks cautiously hopeful, current World and US events will have ripple effects on cost of living, consumer confidence, Financial and Real Estate Markets.

FOR SELLERS: Sellers who don't really need to sell (just "fishing?") should stay off the market, and clear the marketplace for those who REALLY have to sell. UNLESS- you are motivated to Upsize, Downsize or Upgrade – While selling now will "net" less, your next property <u>will cost less</u>. Sharpen your pencil, talk to your CPA and Realtor® to explore the hidden benefits or consequences. Make no assumptions that will sting later.

To be successful, Sellers need to beat competing properties with better property condition, <u>**REALISTIC pricing**</u>, good marketing, and flexible, creative terms (Seller Second Loan, Agreement of Sale, Lease-with-option-to-buy, and Sale-with-lease-back to seller). Days on Market figures show that properties <u>priced right</u> will sell in a reasonable timeframe, often with multiple offers. "Priced Right" is still the determining factor. **BEST Deals are selling, everything else is getting old.**

Pro-Active Sellers are getting their properties **appraised**, **inspected and surveyed** in advance to encourage realistic offers from knowledgeable Buyers. This can prevent unanticipated escrow fallout or Buyers whittling your price down during the transaction when previously unknown facts come to light. **Unrealistic Sellers** continue to be **ignored** by the market and miss <u>current</u> opportunities that later become woefully apparent. They may even end up in a Short Sale or Foreclosure situation that could have been avoided if priced properly.

FOR BUYERS: Very **Low interest rates** prevail, however could inch up. Buyers should get Pre-Approved so they can shop in confidence (fewer last minute disappointments due to non-funding loans). More "short-sales" and foreclosures are happening in the marketplace, yet they can be less of a bargain than they seem, requiring more hurdles to leap and more time (often 4-6 months) to close, if at all. Be prepared, but BE REALISTIC. Lenders are much more stringent now on requirements for loan approval.

<u>First-Time Home Buyers</u> – Many programs are available.... Attend a First-Time Home Buyers workshop, get familiar with the process, get qualified/approved, do your homework to get your own home. Many current owners **never thought they would be able to own** until they attended a workshop, discovered they could own a home, and are glad they did.

This low point in the market is your rare chance, so check it out carefully.

Disclaimer: Zooming in on the figures of a specific geographic area or property type may lead to different conclusions that looking at the overall view.

Maui's market place is much smaller than Oahu's, and a few high or low sales have a greater effect on the statistical numbers without necessarily indicating a big market swing one way or another.




Sales Unit Volume By Month




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Sales Days on Market By Month




